follow signs at exit 45 to Home.

follow signs at exit 45 to Home.

The New Jersey Firemen's Home is a historic landmark in Boonton, New Jersey. Conveniently reached from exit 45 off Rt. 287, the Home rests on 80+ acres with some of the most scenic property in Morris County.



The Firemen's Home - Chartered by the New Jersey State Legislature in 1898 - took in its first firefighters on September 22, 1900. The Home is governed by a Board of Managers, who are elected from each county in the State of New Jersey. Meetings are held and applications for admission are processed on the second Saturday of each month.



Each of our Nursing floors is staffed 24 hours a day with licensed nurses and aides. The Home's physician makes rounds 5 days a week and is on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Licensed and regularly inspected by the NJ State Department of Health, the Firemen's Home offers Long Term Care and Residential Care beds to qualified firefighters, both career and volunteer, throughout the State of New Jersey.



The Chapel at the Home offers a place for those in need. A Catholic Mass is offered once a month, Communion three times per month, and our Chaplain is available upon request.

A firefighter's room is a place to call home and to keep the memories of service very much alive.

Our auditorium is used for visiting our guests and for entertainment. Bingo, movies, concerts, parties, and other special events and programs are provided not only by our Activities Department, but by Fire Departments, Ladies Auxiliaries, and service organizations throughout the state.
